



Pulau Pangkil – Media Enquiries Brochure

We welcome media enquiries and visits. Here is some basic information about the island to get you started:

Pulau Pangkil Kecil was bought by an Indonesian 'PT' company in 1993. The layout design was by the manager at the time, Mr Peter Timmer, an American sailor, as well as the owner. A local contractor, Mr Miznu, was key to building the resort and the amazing swimming pool, and our staff, many of whom are still with us, supplied much of the labour.

The design of the Driftwood Palaces does not reflect any particular part of Indonesia but rather solid Indonesian workmanship using many natural materials including driftwood.

The resort is formally registered with the Indonesian government and was opened to the public in 1998. The majority of our guests are expatriates based in Singapore. We do not have any natural water on the island and bring all fresh water from a well on Bintan Island.

Everyone loves our 'fusion cuisine'. Our cooks originally cooked for the construction site workers and have been taught how to cater for western tastes in subsequent years.

We have over 25 staff. The majority originally come from Java but are now happily based on Pangkil or Bintan. We carefully vet all staff and know all of their families and backgrounds.

We own a further six island and are currently building another luxury resort on an island called Suka. This is expected to open in late 2005. It has its own website:
